**LARGE GROUP DISCOUNT PRICES

Schools and Districts that wish to build TREC into their curriculum are rewarded with volume discount prices. However, please follow these guidelines:

- Schools/districts should expect to schedule 1 day/160 students (i.e. a district bringing 640 children should expect that the school will visit over at least 4 days)
- Those bringing over 499 students should have 1 point of contact who schedules all
 visits at one time (rather than having individual teachers calling to schedule)
- Those wishing to bring 160 1499 students must call to schedule a meeting/phone conversation with the Sales Coordinator and the Environmental Education Specialist Supervisor. This meeting should take place in:
 - September for programs to be scheduled the following March August
 - January for programs to be scheduled for the following September February
- Schools/districts wishing to bring 1500+ students must call to schedule a meeting
 with the Sales Coordinator and Environmental Education Specialist at least 1 full
 year in advance of the first scheduled visit.
